Grading Policy

Classwork / Homework (20%):

<u>Participation (30%)</u>: Active and positive contribution to classwork and class discussion both as an individual and as part of a group. Work reflects effort and independent scholarship between classes. Demonstrates respect for peers, is prompt and prepared, and maintains class materials appropriately.

Projects (20%): Successful completion of planned projects and presentations.

Quizzes (30%): Written quizzes on chosen class topics, demonstrating mastery of material and concepts from classwork, readings, presentations, and individual exploratory work. Listening quizzes reinforcing musical concepts related to chosen topics.
